## Communications/Knowing what's going on/Keeping in Contact

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Act states that individuals have to provide what contact details they want organisations to have about themselves and give their permission for who is allowed to use them and for what purpose. It is a legal requirement that this information is reviewed and consent resought annually.

In the next month or so, the Church Administrators will be asking everyone to complete and sign a form providing the information that they are willing to share with the leadership of the Church, that is; the Minister, Trustees, Safeguarding Officer, Pastoral Secretary and the Administrators of Rivercourt Church. The information will be used to keep you informed on any events planned.

If you do not wish Rivercourt to have any information about you, or for anyone from the Church to make contact with you, you should indicate this on the form and return the form to the church.

Rivercourt will store the original data forms in a secure place. Your data will not be given to or shared with any third parties.

Rivercourt Methodist Church has a Website, Facebook account and a WhatsApp group. The Church is

developing its on line presence and may develop other social media accounts. The Church is using electronic means of contact more and if you do not have access to a computer and/or email, if you want to be kept informed, the church knows how you can be contacted.

The Methodist Church has a very comprehensive Privacy Policy regarding data which can be viewed on the website. <u>www.methodist.org.uk</u>. We can provide printed copies of this if anyone wishes.

Inclusion on any communication platform such as email or distribution list and WhatsApp for the circulation of information such as newsletters or events cannot happen without a completed and signed data consent form.

The existing WhatsApp group will be discontinued and deleted at the end of May. Sign up now, so you don't miss out.
